Tree Tops Jungle Lodge the unique and original experience it is, and they remain its most important asset. They are local, highly experienced in the ways of the jungle, and it is their tracking ability which makes the experience so special, rather than your busiest working environment. They lead the walks on an ad hoc basis – but generally they will suggest an early morning local bird walk, a jungle walk after breakfast and then elephant watching in the late afternoon when the animals tend to head down to the lake for a drink.

We think that the camp is lovely all year round and even without elephants, the local wildlife spotting is fantastic. However, the dry season, from March through to mid-October is the best for spotting elephants and the absolute height of the dry season (July-September) is when the drought forces the elephants to come to just a few places to drink.

This is a genuinely remote location and a true wilderness experience. Guests should not expect high end, African-style safari service here. But, they will be very well looked after in a beautiful and fascinating region of Sri Lanka, with an unforgettable experience, which is all we want for our guests.
