

Wilpattu Safari Camp



Wilpattu Safari Camp is nestled in five acres of wooded forest truck between seasonal village rice field and forest cover of the national park. Tents are sited among the shared of trees. Wilpattu National Park is recovering from 30 years of closure due to the war, It is not crowded unlike other parks in Sri Lanka giving way to much more relaxed and insightful safari experience. Before its closure Wilpattu was the premier location for day light viewing of leopards in the world.

We have 4 guest tents and our camp is located less than 10 minutes drive from the Park entrance. We use this experience to ensure that guests enjoy the entire journey through the wild rather than run after "sightings" only. Guests will be accompanied on safari by an experienced naturalist or wildlife photographer. As wildlife photographers and conservationists we are conscious of our impact on the environment and the experience our guest enjoy. The relatively small size of our campsite permits us to give a more personalized service to our guests.

The camp has been limited to 4 gest tents that can accommodate 8 guests. The safari tents have been custom designed to our specifications and comprise a verandah area, the bedroom and attached toilet, each room has been furnished to provide much combatable style in the campsite.
